



Project 668 Membership Programme Terms and Conditions

The present Terms and Conditions apply between the *Member* and Project 668.

Article 1 – Scope

The present Terms and Conditions govern Project 668 Membership Programme as specified below.

Article 2 – Membership fee

To benefit from Project 668 Membership Programme, the *Member* has to pay a fee of:

- Basic membership: 12 Euro
- Premium membership: 25 Euro
- Supporter: Optional - free donation, minimum 5 Euro

In case a *Member* is in possession of a valid T-Card (the card is released by the Trainees' Committee of the European Commission), he/she is granted a discount on the Membership fees equal to:

- Basic membership: 10 Euro (instead of 12)
- Premium membership: 20 Euro (instead of 25)

The Membership fee is to be paid once in a lifetime. The Membership Programme is activated upon receipt of the fee and the *Member* can benefit from it as long as he/she wishes and the Programme is running.

Article 3 – Member's Rights

Through the payment of the fee, the *Member* is entitled to:

- Basic membership:
 - ❖ Monthly newsletter with job offers and event notifications [*Project 668 commits not to share job offers with non-members*];
 - ❖ Access to the LinkedIn group for *Members*;
 - ❖ CV check (10-minute session) either in person, via Skype or by email;
 - ❖ 10% discount for all Project 668's events that require a fee.
- Premium membership:
 - ❖ Monthly newsletter with job offers and event notifications [*Project 668 commits not to share job offers with non-members*];
 - ❖ Access to the LinkedIn group for *Members*;
 - ❖ CV check (10-minute session) either in person, via Skype or by email;
 - ❖ Career orientation session (30-minute session), either in person or via Skype, including either consultation on the next career steps or a job application preparation.
 - ❖ 20% discount and prior booking for all Project 668's events that require a fee.
- Supporter:
 - ❖ Monthly newsletter, if agreed in the registration form;
 - ❖ Become a potential speaker in seminars, webinars or conferences organized by Project 668.

Article 4 – Duration

The present Terms and Conditions enter into force and come into effect when the *Member* has paid the Membership fee specified in Article 2. They shall terminate if the *Member* notifies Project 668 of his/her intention to terminate the Membership Programme. Such notification shall be made to membership@project668.org and shall be effective immediately from the reception of the notification by Project 668. In the event that the *Member* wants to benefit again from the Membership Programme, he/she shall have to pay a new Membership fee as specified in Article 2.

Article 5 – Update

In the event that Project 668 updates, changes or complements the present Terms and Conditions, it shall first inform the *Member*. The *Member* will have a reasonable delay to notify whether it accepts the new Terms and Conditions or refuses them. If the *Member* refuses them, it shall no longer benefit from the Membership Programme. In case that the *Member* has refused the new Terms and Conditions but later wants to benefit again from the Membership Programme, he/she shall pay a new Membership fee, which implies an acceptance of the new Terms and Conditions.

Article 6 – Applicable law and jurisdiction

The present Terms and Conditions are subject to the law of Belgium. In the event that any dispute arises between the *Member* and Project 668 as to their application, content, interpretation, or as to any issue related to the Personal Data, the *Member* commits to notify Project 668 of the issue(s) at the email address indicated in Article 8 below. The Parties will try to solve the issues amicably. Without any resolution of the dispute within ninety (90) days of the notification by the *Member* to Project 668, the courts of Brussels shall have the exclusive jurisdiction to settle the dispute. The proceedings shall be in English or French, depending on the common language of the Parties.

Article 7 – Liability

Project 668 Membership Programme and the present Terms and Conditions are provided «as is». Project 668 makes no representation or warranties of any kind, express or implied, as to the Membership Programme, its social media channels, or information, content, materials or services included thereon, including, but not limited to, implied warranties of merchantability and fitness for a particular purpose.

Article 8 – Intellectual Property Rights

The logos used by Project 668 on its social media channels, in its newsletter and on its website are exclusive property of Project 668 or Project 668's partners. The *Member* has no right to reproduce these logos for commercial purposes or for purposes that would be detrimental to Project 668 and/or its partners.

Articles shared by Project 668 may be subject to copyright belonging to Project 668 or another group. In order to comply with copyright protection, in the event that the *Member* shares articles that he/she has found on any Project 668 social media channel and/or received by Project 668 (e.g. in the newsletter), the *Member* shall provide the initial source (original website/social media) and the name of the author. The *Member* shall neither use articles in his/her name nor use the articles in a prejudicial way to the author. In the event that the *Member* is accused by any external party of copyright infringement related to any article previously shared by Project 668, Project 668 shall in no event be liable.

Similarly, in the event that the User uses an external party's logo and/or trademark put on an article shared by Project 668, Project 668 shall in no event be liable for that use.
